

## TECHNICAL BULLETIN Takiron Pathways Ramp Use

There have been a number of inquiries on the use of this product for indoor and outdoor ramps.

The product, as manufactured, exceeds the 0.8 Coefficient of Friction (COF) which was once detailed under the American with Disabilities Act, Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG) 2002, as an acceptable COF for ramped surfaces. Thus, the product can be used in these areas subject to the following conditions:

- ◆ Like all similar resilient flooring, Pathways' COF will be influenced by maintenance, debris build-up on the flooring, and wear;
- ◆ Ramps will in time see a reduction in the COF given wear to the product's surface;
- ◆ Heavily used ramps will require a more frequent product replacement cycle;
- ◆ In all cases, ramps need to be designed in accordance with current ADA Standards for Accessible Design.
